



Camp Sunrise Inc. 2023 Vaccination Protocols

We are excited to hold camp in-person again in 2024! Maintaining the safety of our campers and staff is our top priority. Considering the situation with COVID-19, we will adhere to the following safety protocols the week of camp.

Childhood Vaccination Requirements

- We do require all campers to have their childhood vaccinations as per the CDC guidelines (unless they are medically exempt). We have campers who are immunocompromised and this is one way to protect them from these common, although rare, illnesses.

COVID-19 Vaccination Recommendations

- We recommend that all staff, campers, and day volunteers have the primary series of vaccinations but are **not required** to be fully vaccinated.
- A primary series is considered 2 doses of Moderna or Pfizer and 1 dose of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
- Please refer to the [CDC guidelines](#) for the current recommendations depending on your age and health status.

COVID-19 Testing

- Testing protocols are subject to change as we continue to monitor COVID -19. More information will be provided closer to the week of camp.

As of right now -

- All staff, LITs, day volunteers, and campers are **NOT** being required to get a COVID -19 test prior to camp OR before entering camp.

COVID-19 Cases

- If a camper or staff presents with any COVID-19 related symptoms during camp, they will be sent home to protect other campers and staff.
- Parents will be notified if a camper or staff test positive for COVID-19. We will inform parents of any close contact the infected individual may have had with their child.
- If three people in a cabin test positive, we will send the entire cabin home to protect other campers and staff.

COVID-19 Safety

- Adaptions regarding the use of facilities, large gatherings of people, and indoor activities may be subject to change for the safety of our staff and campers.
- We will be conscientious about cleaning the facilities and equipment.
